Subject: Re-organization of the Laval High Schools

Dear parents:

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you back to a new and exciting school year. Over the course of the coming months, we will be preparing the second phase of the re-organization of the Laval high schools.

As you are aware, the Council of Commissioners, at its meeting on June 25, 2014, approved a resolution to modify the organization of educational services in the 4 (four) Laval High Schools in an effort to alleviate the registration imbalances and public perception of the Laval High Schools and to provide stability for the Laval community.

The high schools were organized as follows until June 30, 2014:

- 1 junior high school and 1 senior high school in the 2323 Daniel-Johnson building (Mother Teresa Junior High and Laurier Senior High)
- 1 junior high school and 1 senior high school in the 3200 Souvenir building (Laval Junior High and Laval Liberty High)

PHASE 1

As of July 1, 2014, Phase 1 of the re-organization was implemented and the schools in Laval are now organized as follows until June 30, 2015:

- 2 junior high schools in the 2323 Daniel-Johnson building (Mother Teresa Junior High and Laval Junior High)
- 2 senior high schools in the 3200 Souvenir building (Laurier Senior High and Laval Liberty High)

PHASE 2

Following an extensive public consultation in the spring of 2014, the Council of Commissioners approved that as of July 1, 2015, Phase 2 of the re-organization will be implemented and the high schools will be organized as follows:

- 1 junior high school in the 2323 Daniel-Johnson building (name of the school to be determined)
- 1 senior high school in the 3200 Souvenir building (name of the school to be determined)

In order to carry out this change, the four current high schools (Mother Teresa Junior High School, Laval Junior High School, Laurier Senior High School and Laval Liberty High School) will be closed as of July 1, 2015, and 2 new high schools will be created.

This re-organization will offer the students in Laval increased opportunities in their high school education.

We look forward to the next months of planning and visioning for these new schools, and rely on you to share your ideas through a needs assessment which will be conducted this fall.

We also invite you to get involved by attending the General Assembly of Parents at the following dates where 2 Provisional Governing Boards for the new schools will be created to help in preparing for the 2015-2016 school year:
